Audition Requirements:

1. Solo of applicant's choice. (No more than 3 minutes. Please include the main expository or main thematic section from either the first or final movement.)

2. Excerpts:

(All Trumpet I parts)

Beethoven: Fidelio Overture No. 3 – Offstage Fanfare Brahms: Academic Festival Overture – mm. 63-92

Dvorak: Symphony No. 8 – Movement IV, Beginning to measure 18

R. Strauss: Death and Transfiguration – 11 measures after Rehearsal "Y" to Rehearsal "Z" Stravinsky: Petrushka – Ballerina's Dance (1 measure before Rehearsal "69" to Rehearsal "70)

Tchaikovsky: Symphony No. 4 – Movement I, mm. 7 to Rehearsal "A"

- 2. Request a live audition on Tuesday, October 5, 2021 at Milligan University (auditions will begin at 5:00 p.m.) by calling or emailing the audition contact below.

Both methods of audition submission will receive equal consideration by the audition committee.
